Voting Bias

Everyone has an bias:

- Citizens
 - Want free and fair elections
 - And want them to cost very little



Voting Bias

- Clerks
 - Want smooth, well-run elections
 - May want to look favorable for his/her own next election



Voting Bias

- Candidates and Elected Officials
 - Want to be elected
 - May be suspicious of the system
 - May want to “work” the system
